Artist form:

Booth includes

1) All booths will be 10x10. If you purchase a double booth every item listed will ensue. They will include two 8' table and 4 chairs. 1 trash can.

All decorations will be up to lessee. Tables will be bare.

2) Electricity will be provided to each booth. Bring extension chords to be on safe side.

3) Trash liners will be changed by event staff. In the event your trash needs emptying, please just notify event staff and it will be changed promptly

4) Entire event (for indoor) booths will have pipe and drape provided. Event will provide hooks to hang banners. Please don't puncture holes into pipe and drape or HOTC will have to charge you for damages.

5) Each booth will have 3 lanyards for vendors. This will insure you get into event early, as well as parking for the event. This includes loading up and tear down.

6) Small mason jar to collect tickets for "Best Booth" contest.

What you need to know:

We want everyone to have fun, so this convention will be a bit different. Every attendee will receive a ticket to vote for best booth of the show. This means that we want every booth to be inviting and a visual marvel. The cooler your booth, the more votes you get. Tickets will be counted midday on second day of event. Everyone should try and win this!

The event will provide music. Please refrain from loud music in your booth. All the live music will stay outside. Please remember to be respectful to everyone. We are sharing the space with others.

The event holds the right to remove anyone with no return of booth fee. Please do your best to keep your hands to yourself. Any fighting will be an automatic removal and banned from future events. In the event that there is some sort of conflict, please advise event staff and or security. It will be handled promptly.

We are on the side of the vendors. If any patron becomes an issue for any reason, let event staff know.

Event is not held liable for theft during or at anytime of the event. Please be mindful of the booth. We are all here to have fun, build community, and make some money at the same time. It's up to all of us to make this event amazing. Vendors must stay for the duration of the event. Booths must stay open while convention is open to public.

The Friday before the event, the event will be having a meet and greet for vendors, artists, and musicians. Appetizers will be provided. Drinks are on you. Event will be held at

host hotel. Our hope is that we start building community the night before to set the tone for the show.

Santa Barbara Health dept. requirements are as listed. Each artist will need to be registered with a temporary registration for the event. Also a current blood born pathogen certification is needed to participate in live tattooing at the event. The health dept must verify each artist in person before the event. That being said. Im hoping to get everything done on the Friday before the event. Setup will be on Friday before the meet and greet at the host hotel. That way Saturday morning all you will have to do is show up and set up. The hope is to make a less stressful experience. I have done many conventions. And my favorite ones are always the ones that are less stressful.
